This template is for labels 99.1mm x 38.1mm (14 to a page). If you do not have these labels go to the end of the page

You will need:

- Labels
- Toothpicks
- Cake!

How to use:

1. Open the PDF
2. Load the printer with the correct size labels.
3. Press print
4. Peel the labels off and place a wooden toothpick in the middle of the label on the sticky side, fold in half so that the sticky sides stick together.



Other ideas

- Stick onto straws and have your own SaLT punch!
- Brownies, flapjacks, lots of different unhealthy or healthy treats to stick these into!
- These can be used during better speech and hearing month (May!), during baking sales, staff or parent training...

But I don't have any Labels?

No fear, print out onto nice sturdy paper, cut out each individual one and glue the back. Then fold this in half and you'll have the same 'flag' effect!
